

## What is Alpha?

Alpha is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith, typically run over eleven weeks. Each talk looks at a different question around faith & is designed to create conversation. Alpha is run all around the globe, & all are welcome.

### What to Expect – A Typical Alpha

Alpha runs in cafés, churches, universities, homes –you name it. No two Alphas look the same, but they generally have three key things in common: food, a talk and good conversation.

**First up there's Food.** Whether it's a group of friends gathered around a kitchen table, or a quick catch-up over coffee and cake, food has a way of bringing people together. It's no different at Alpha. We start with food, because it's a great way to encourage community and get to know each other.

**Then a Talk.** The talks are designed to engage and inspire conversation. Generally thirty minutes long, they can be given as a live talk or played as a video. They explore the big issues around faith and unpack the basics of Christianity, addressing questions such as *Who is Jesus?* and *How can we have faith?*

**Followed by Discussion.** Probably the most important part of any Alpha: the chance to share thoughts and ideas on the topic, and simply discuss it in a small group. There's no obligation to say anything. And there's nothing you can't say. It's an opportunity to hear from others and contribute your own perspective in an honest, friendly and open environment.

### So what do we need from you?

**Pre-registration** It is important for individuals to be pre-registered so that the Hosts and Helpers can be sure to have enough food prepared, and that there are adequate materials available.

**How do I register?** Call the parish office at 402-336-1602 and simply leave your name and we will add you to our list.

**How many can participate?** For this ALPHA we are capping the number at 50 participants.

**Will there be another opportunity for me to attend if I cannot commit this time?** Yes, typically once a parish starts ALPHA there are two to three sessions per year.

**Is there a cost?** No, there is no charge for you to participate in the ALPHA program, the parish and the hosts and helpers provide all that's needed.

**When does ALPHA begin?** The first session will be at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 7th at St. Patrick's Parish Hall. Subsequent sessions will be held in the Hosts Homes on a mutually agreed upon day of the week and time.

**What if I can't make it to every session?** Ideally we would hope that everyone who attends can participate in all the sessions and the retreat day. However we know that there are many things that can contribute to an absence.

**What's in it for me?** A deeper relationship with the person of Jesus Christ and the chance to get to know other like-minded individuals who want to begin or to strengthen their relationship with Jesus.


### 08/22/18 Minutes Summary

  - Parish Picnic & Playground Blessing had nearly 250 people in attendance, and was well received. We will plan to do this again next year.
  - Listening sessions results were reviewed. Council, committees, and staff will continue to strategize for igniting our faith. An online survey will be sent out to all parishioners.
  - New Ministries need to be developed, with a reminder to reach out into our parish for leadership. Suggestions include: homebound visits and surrounding parishes shared music ministry.
  - Twelve week Alpha program will start in October, with each group to pick their own time. Each group will pick their own meeting time, and leaders are encouraged to reach out to new people.
  - There was discussion of making children more visible at masses, including children's choir.
